Requirements

It is the responsibility of the client (Adam Valentiner) to provide any graphics, text, or any other data that is to be incorporated into the site with notes on how it is wished to be used within one week of acceptance and sign-off of this project. Any area where necessary data is not provided then “dummy text” will be input simply to display text location and can be replaced after completion of the project either by the client or by me, the designer, for an additional charge.

Estimate with explanation of services being done

By request and signature below of the client, Adam Valentiner, I, Adam Despain, am to design, build, and publish a new website for CCSN’s Automotive department of applied technologies. The first stage of this project takes place after a non-refundable deposit of \$100.00 is place. In this stage I will sketch a series of thumbnails, providing at least two unique options for the overall design and layout of the site. A flowchart will also be assembled, showing all the pages that are to be created and where they will be in relationship to one another. At completion of this stage a second sign-off will take place. Here the client makes a final decision of which layout is preferred and what, if any, colors are required to be incorporated into the design. With this second signature the client agrees to pay the design and development fee of \$75.00 per hour with a minimum of 5 hours and maximum of 10 hours to be documented by myself, Adam Despain, and used over the period of 3 weeks from date of the second signature.

At completion of the project, an additional fee of \$100.00 is optional for setup of a hosting account and registration of a “.com” domain chosen by the client with any costs incurred also be paid by the client, Adam Valentiner.

Any future maintenance of the site can be done by myself, Adam Despain, at the same rate of \$75.00 per hour accepted at my own discretion with this document.
